## BowCast at the Bird – 3D Info

### **For the New Breed of Bowhunters**

Welcome to the second annual BowCast 3D Shoot. The purpose of this section is to pass along some information to the BowCast at the Bird attendees about the 3D “Fun” shoot. On the left you will see the agenda for both days of this event. Below you will see some general guidelines for the shoot.

### **3D Guidelines**

- 1) Cases should be left in your car or hotel room and attendees should board the ski lift with only their bows, quivers, arrows, and daypack.
- 2) Attendees should need NO More than 6 arrows, but they are welcome to carry as many as they would like.
- 3) Hydration – We will be providing water on the course; Feel free to also pack water up to the course.
- 4) Snacks – If you like to shoot, it could be a long day – throw some snacks in your daypack. Breakfast and Lunch will be available at “Base Camp” at the bottom of the mountain.

- 5) Even at altitude, it could still be very HOT; Be prepared:
  - a. Sunscreen
  - b. Hat or Visor
  - c. Light Breathable clothing
  - d. Soft shell or rain top just in case
  - e. Comfortable shoes – light hikers or sneakers should be fine.
- 6) Extras – Make sure your bow is in working condition. There will be a “warm up” area and we’ll probably have a few field tools, but you may want to pack an Allen wrench in your day pack. (NO Broadheads allowed on the 3D Course).
- 7) No Drugs or Alcohol on the course
- 8) If you have any physical limitations, please let us know at the check in desk.
- 9) We will be in and around private grounds, so please respect the property
- 10) Have fun and be safe!
